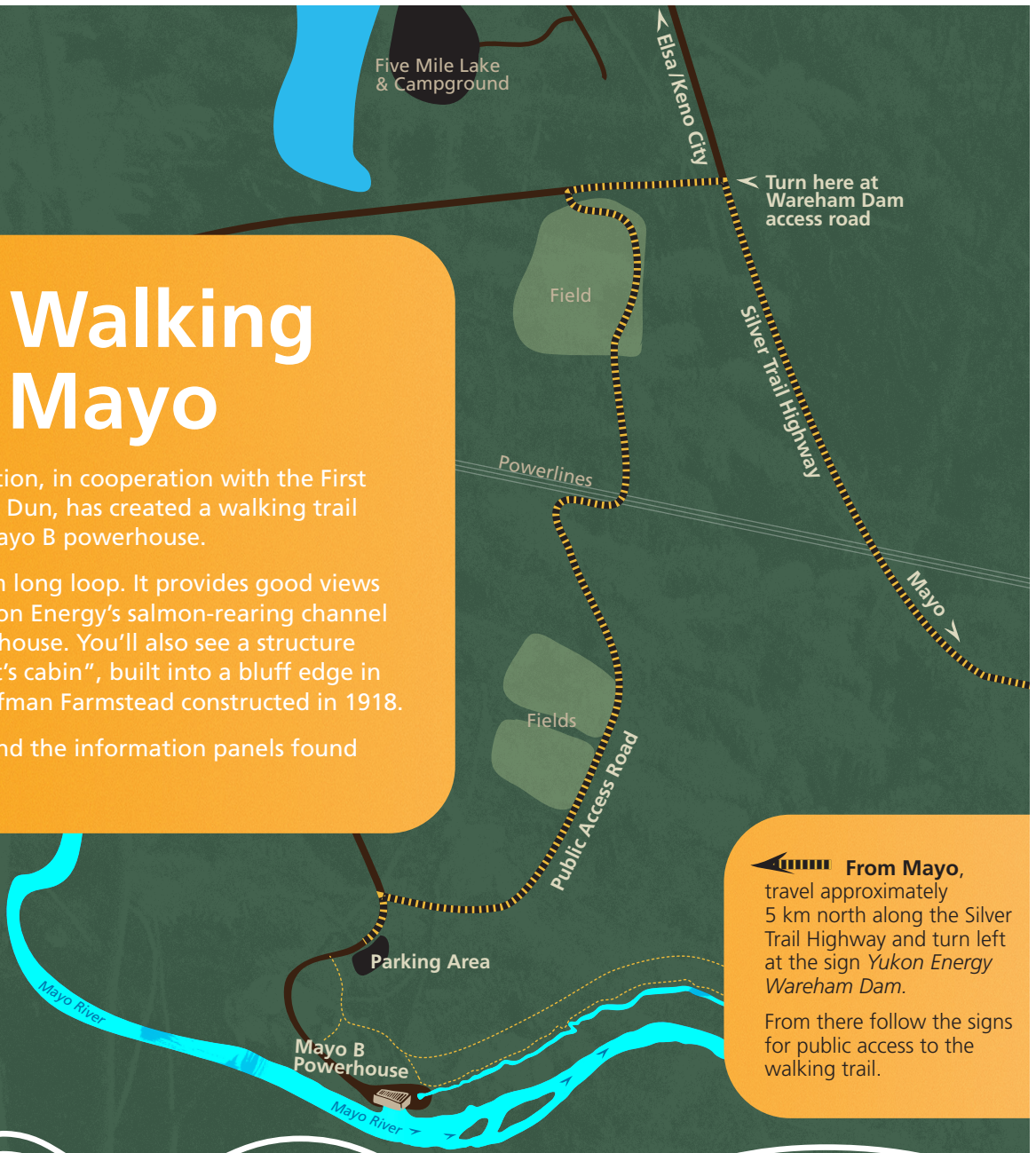


A New Walking Trail in Mayo

Yukon Energy Corporation, in cooperation with the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyäk Dun, has created a walking trail in the vicinity of the Mayo B powerhouse.

The trail forms a 2.5 km long loop. It provides good views of the Mayo River, Yukon Energy's salmon-rearing channel and the Mayo B powerhouse. You'll also see a structure nicknamed the "hermit's cabin", built into a bluff edge in the 1970s, and the Huffman Farmstead constructed in 1918.

Please enjoy the trail and the information panels found along the way.



From Mayo, travel approximately 5 km north along the Silver Trail Highway and turn left at the sign Yukon Energy Wareham Dam. From there follow the signs for public access to the walking trail.
