What will you do: As a vital member of the Plant Operator team, you will:

- Adheres to the Corporation's safety standards by following approved Safe Work Practices and both Worker- and Operator-Administered Protection Plans.
- Operates and monitors prime movers (including rental units) and auxiliary equipment in accordance with operational requirements.
- Conducts daily, weekly, and monthly inspections and readings on plant and rental generators and associated equipment.
- De-energizes, isolates, re-energizes, and returns plant equipment and auxiliary systems to service in accordance with established procedures.
- Performs or assists with maintenance and repair of generating units, auxiliary systems, infrastructure, and yard equipment.
- Coordinates and oversees contractors for operational support activities including building and yard maintenance, spill response, remediation, snow removal, and waste management.
- Manages plant inventory, including ordering, receiving, and tracking parts and supplies.
- Assists with or performs month-end plant readings and meter readings as required.
- Acts as the initial site contact and lead during emergency situations.
