Responsibilities:

- Operate and manage Yukon Energy's power grids to ensure safe, reliable, and efficient performance.
- Monitor and adjust generation and transmission as needed, and forecast system requirements to maintain adequate reserves.
- Respond efficiently to restore the system following disturbances and outages.
- Serve as the point of contact for switching procedures and work protection permits on Yukon Energy assets.
