BOARD ORDER 2019-08

WHEREAS:

- A. On June 22, 2017, Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC), filed an application with the Yukon Utilities Board (Board), pursuant to the *Public Utilities Act* (Act) and Order-In-Council 1995/90, requesting an order approving a forecast revenue requirement for 2017 and 2018.
- B. The Board issued Board Order 2018-10 on December 27, 2018, and ordered as follows:
 - 1. YEC is to submit a compliance filing to the Board within 60 days of issuance of this Order in accordance with the directions set out in the reasons found in Appendix A;
 - 2. The 2017 and 2018 revenue requirement for YEC is approved with the changes directed in the reasons set out in Appendix A; and
 - 3. YEC is directed to provide a new Low Water Reserve Account to replace the DCF in compliance with the directions as set out in Appendix A to this decision. YEC is further directed to amend the ERA portion of Rate Schedule 42 to comply with the directions as provided in Appendix A to this decision.
- C. On February 25, 2019, YEC filed with the Board its compliance filing with respect to its 2017-18 General Rate Application (GRA) and Board Order 2018-10.
- D. The Board issued Board Order 2019-04 on September 12, 2019, and ordered that:
 - YEC is to submit a compliance filing to the Board within 60 days of issuance of that Order in accordance with the directions set out in the reasons found in Appendix A.

- E. On September 23, 2019, YEC submitted to the Board its second compliance filing with respect to Board Order 2018-10 and Board Order 2019-04.
- F. The Board issued Board Order 2019-06 on September 27, 2019, outlining the process that YEC's 2017-18 GRA second compliance filing would follow.
- G. The Board received a motion from the Utilities Consumers' Group (UCG) regarding further and better information responses on October 23, 2019.
- H. The Board issued a memorandum on October 23, 2019, outlining the process with respect to the UCG motion.
- I. Following the process for the UCG motion, the Board provided its determinations on the UCG motion in Board Order 2019-07, issued October 25, 2019. That Board Order also provided the schedule for the remaining process.
- J. The process deadlines as outlined in Board Order 2019-07 were met and the Board considers the record for this proceeding to have closed on November 5, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the reasons set out in Appendix A to this Board Order, the Board:

1. Accepts the second compliance filing as submitted by YEC subject to any directions provided in Appendix A to this Board Order;
2. Directs YEC to incorporate the directions contained in Appendix A to this Board Order as part of its next GRA; and
3. Approves Rider J and Rider J1 for all consumption commencing December 1, 2019, as outlined on page 2 of Appendix A to this Decision.
