Job Title: Casual Plant Operator

Department: Operations

Reports to: Senior Plant Operator

SUMMARY

Under the general supervision of the Sr. Plant Operator, the incumbent is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the electrical generating units, plants and their respective auxiliary equipment and may be required to provide maintenance of generating equipment.

DESCRIPTION

1. Adheres to the Corporation's high safety standards by following approved safe working plans and worker administered and operator administered protection plans.
2. Monitors and operates prime movers and auxiliary equipment as per operational requirements. Logs all necessary readings.
3. De-energizes and isolates / energizes and returns to service equipment and their respective auxiliary equipment as per standard procedures.
4. Assists in system restoration following a system disturbance under the direction of the control centre operator.
5. Performs daily/weekly/monthly plant checks and unit readings on plant generations and peripheral equipment.
6. Monitors building heat and airflows as well as performs site security at facilities.
7. Maintains clean plants and surrounding areas.
8. Assists or performs maintenance on mechanical equipment as required.
9. Assists with month end plant readings.
10. Maintains the confidentiality of all Corporation information. Adheres to all Corporation policies, procedures and guidelines.
