What will you do: The Maintenance Mechanical works as part of the Mechanical Maintenance team, performing Journey level mechanical/millwright work in the installation, repair and maintenance of various pieces of electrical generating units: hydro, diesel, natural gas and wind and their respective auxiliary equipment in a safe, reliable and efficient manner. This position includes plant operator's responsibilities as operationally required.

This position requires regular travel throughout the territory and periods of stand-by coverage.

What you need to succeed:

- Journey certification as a heavy equipment mechanic or millwright with welding experience and several years' previous mechanical and millwright experience, two of which are in a power generation environment.
- Knowledge of Windows based computer software applications.
- Certification in WHIMS, TDG, rigging and hoisting, confined space and fall arrest.
- Strong client service orientation with good interpersonal skills
- A proven track record and commitment to safe procedures and encouraging a safe work environment.
- A valid First Aid Certificate
- Ability to work in a team and cross cultural environment.
