Summary of Application

The Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC) has filed a General Rate Application with the Yukon Utilities Board (Board) requesting an order approving its forecast revenue requirements for the three-year test period 2025 to 2027 (Application). If approved, this could mean monthly bill increases for Yukon residents, businesses and industrial customers in 2025, 2026, and 2027.

YEC is the main generator and transmitter of electrical energy in the Yukon directly serving over 2,700 customers in and around Dawson City, Mayo and Faro and southern Yukon. Yukon Energy also provides power to other Yukon communities through ATCO Electric Yukon (AEY).

Technical Workshop

YEC will hold a technical workshop regarding the Application to assist the public in gaining a better understanding of the Application and process surrounding the application.

Interventions

Interveners actively participate in a proceeding, including the filing of evidence (if needed), argument, and reply argument. Interveners intending to participate in the hearing and other process steps are to register in writing with the Board's Executive Secretary by **no later than June 6, 2025**, indicating their name, contact information, the nature of their interest and the issues of interest in relation to the Application. Interveners are also to submit any comments regarding YEC's interim rate request at that time.

YEC is seeking approval of forecast net revenue requirements of \$107.392 million for 2025, \$122.406 million for 2026, and \$134.850 million for 2027. This represents an increase of \$16.048 million for 2025 over the 2024 approved revenue requirement of \$91.344 million (17.6% increase). For 2026, this represents an increase of \$15.014 million over the proposed 2025 revenue requirement (14.0% increase). For 2027, this represents an increase of \$12.444 million over the proposed 2026 revenue requirement (10.2% increase).

In addition, in its Application, YEC is also seeking approval of an interim refundable rate rider (Rider J) increase, effective July 1, 2025, of 17.89%, bringing Rider J to 73.29% applicable to base rates for retail and industrial firm rates, effective. YEC is also requesting a further Rider J increase of 19.66% bringing Rider J to 92.95% for retail and industrial firm rates, effective January 1, 2026. YEC is seeking final rates effective April 1, 2026 for the 2025 and 2026 test years.
