Yukon Utilities Board ("Board") Order 2010-13 directs the companies as follows:

" ... to allow all interested parties to monitor the balance in the Rider F account, the Companies are to provide the Board quarterly acknowledgement filings stating the balance in the Rider F account... "

Please find attached a quarter end report regarding the Companies' combined Diesel and LNG Fuel Price Variance ("Rider F") account balance for the period ended March 31, 2022. Please note that, despite the account balance exceeding the \$200,000 threshold per policy, the utilities are not proposing a rate change at this time due to the ongoing review of Yukon Energy's 2021 GRA. The Companies will address the account balance and file a Rider F rate change advisory letter with the Board when 2021 GRA Compliance Filing is approved by the Board.
